SPEAKER BENEFITS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

BENEFITS

One speaker per paper presentation and up to four speakers per panel presentation will receive complimentary registration for Renewable Energy World 2009. One presenter per paper presentation at Renewable Energy World Europe 2009 will receive a complimentary registration.

PANEL PRESENTATION

Panel sessions give the opportunity for an interactive discussion between conference delegates and the presenters. Manuscripts are not required. If a topic is accepted for a panel presentation the person submitting the application is responsible for procuring the panellists at the time of acceptance. Each panel presentation will be allocated four complimentary conference registrations.
