
The establishment/creation of an Article 185 TEFU Initiative for the Mediterranean (PRIMA).






The aim is to enhance excellence in universities & research centers

Multilevel and multi source financing for achieving our target






The "Horizon 2020"

- ✓ To improve our participation in the thematic calls, (complementarity with the national actions/activities and the NSFRI)
- ✓ Critical importance of the tools addressing the SMEs

✓ Synergies with the Structural Funds on the basis of a well designed national programme/priorities





Hellenic priorities on Research and Innovation

Our main tools are:

- 1. The New Law for Research and Innovation,
- 1. The National Strategic Framework for Research and Innovation (NSFRI) 2014-2020
- 1. The "HORIZON 2020"

- 1. The New Law: An "holistic" Innovative approach all Payers in the R+I process

 To be adopted by the Greek Parliament by the end of February 2014

 A number of innovative provisions of the proposed law:
- ✓ Definition of a National Strategy for Research, Development and Innovation the action plan to be adopted by the Parliament;
- ✓ **General Secretariat for Research, Technology and Innovation (GSRTI)**, acquires a central role, with horizontal coordination of activities across Ministries;
- Establishment of Regional Scientific Councils to activate and coordinate regional initiatives for RDI;
- National progress assessment on research and innovation, in accordance to the indicators of Innovation Union;
- ✓ Incentives to promote the mobility among academia, research and business;
- ✓ Measures for repatriations of Greek scientists from diaspora;
- ✓ Promoting the staircase to excellence incentives (grants, awards...);
- ✓ GSRTI is foreseen to be actively supporting the efforts for the commercialization of research results produced in Research Centers and Universities;
- "Fast Track" procedures to support RDI investments over 1M€;
 - ✓ Funding and monitoring simplification process
