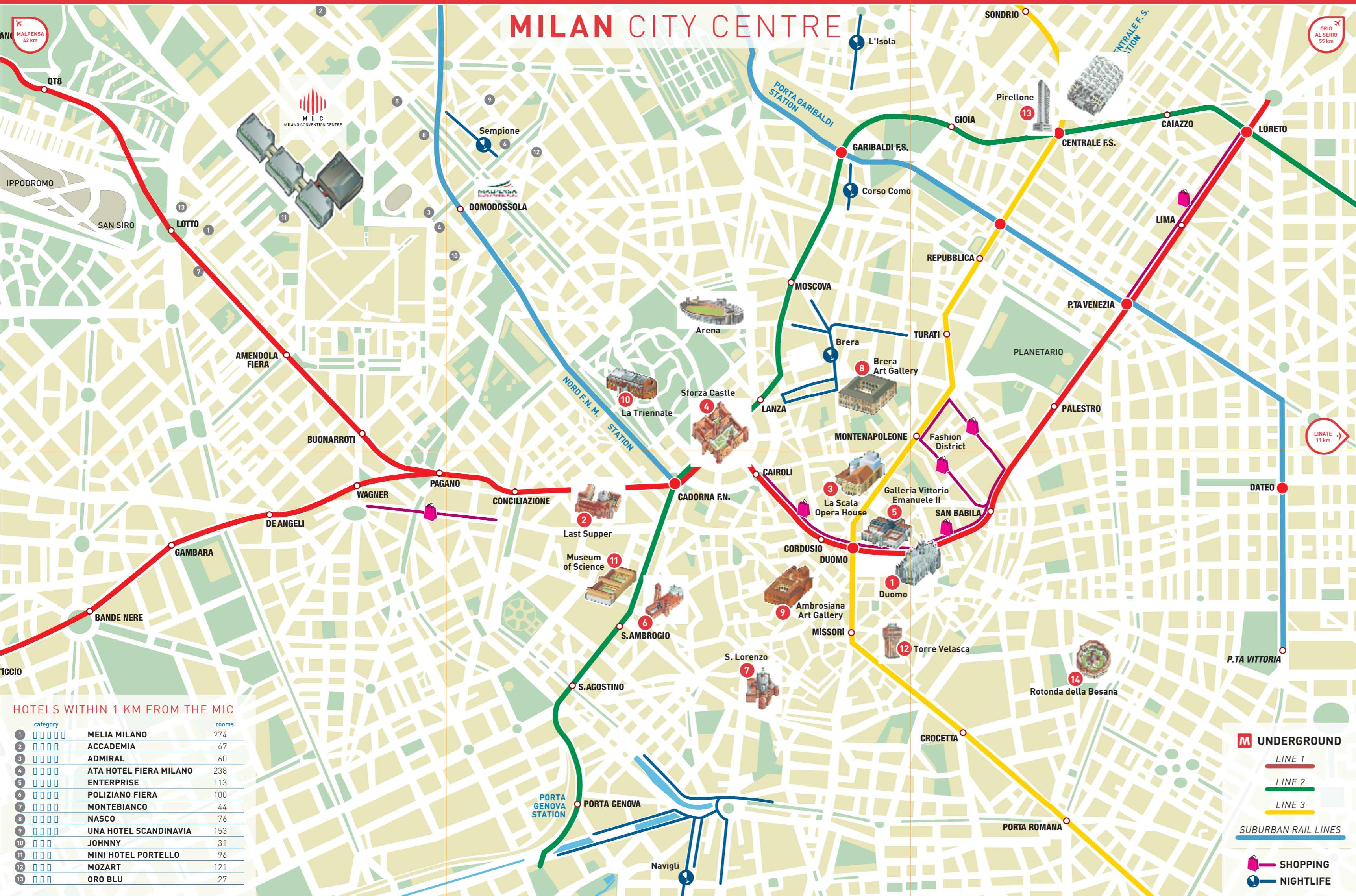


# MILAN HIGHLIGHTS

The 3rd largest church in the world with 3,500 statues




**2 Leonardo's Last Supper**  
A touchstone of Renaissance painting




**3 La Scala**  
The world's greatest opera house




**4 The Sforza Castle**  
A complex of fortresses, castles and towers begun in 1451




**5 Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II**

One of Milan's oldest basilicas (379 a.d.)




**7 S. Lorenzo**

Botticelli, Leonardo, Titian, Caravaggio, Raffaello




**9 The Brera Art Gallery**

The museum of Italian design




**11 Museum of Science and Technology**

This striking skyscraper is an oversized 1950s version of medieval tower design

Designed by Gi Ponti, it was the Milan's first skyscraper. It's 124 m (400 ft) high



**14 Rotonda della Besana**  
One of the most stunning examples of late baroque architecture in Lombardy
